How to participate in The Great Jack-o'-Lantern Spectacular Sail

1. Get a pumpkin. Purchase a pumpkin between 5lbs-10lbs.

Not sure how big that is?

It shouldn't be larger than a basketball.

2. Carve your Jack-o'-Lantern.

Pumpkin must be gutted and carved.

Pumpkin must be cut from the top NOT from the bottom.

Any decorations must be made of natural,
biodegradable materials.

Do not add light bulbs, candles or floats;

a flameless LED tea light candle and floating device will be
provided when Jack-o'-Lantern is dropped off.

3. Drop your Jack-o'-Lantern off on Saturday, October 29 between 10:00AM and 2:00PM at Belmont Lake boat dock.

Jack-o'-Lanterns will not be returned after the sail.

Space to participate in the sail is limited to 60 floats;

Jack-o'-Lantern's that do not meet the requirements for participation or are dropped off after 60 floats have been filled will be put on display (space permitting) during the event and will not be included in the sail.

4. Enjoy the event!

5. Choose your seat and watch the sail.

Once the activities close,
find a spot along the north side of Belmont Lake.
