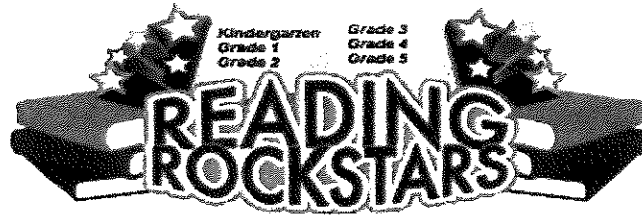


March 4th -15th is Tooker Avenue PARP

You are also receiving a calendar full of School Day PARP activities. Have fun and....

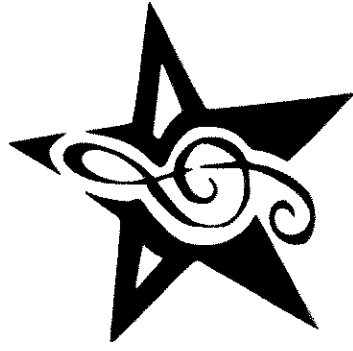
