#151 – Jonah’s Mission for Kids Scholarship

Deadline: April 1, 2024

Criteria: Student must be a graduating senior from a Suffolk County High School interested in pursuing a career in engineering or nursing. The scholarship requires students to write an essay to the prompt: How do you use your voice to improve your school community? How did it positively affect you? Emailed essay should include students name and school district.
