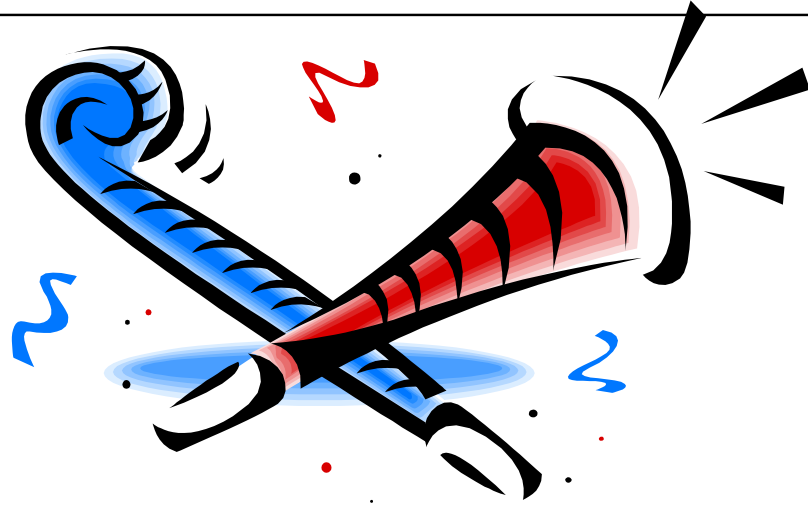

### **#66 – Live Mas Scholarship Program**

Deadline: January 3, 2024  
Criteria: To be eligible for the scholarship a student must be on-track to apply for or enrolled in an accredited post-high school educational program and be a legal resident of the United States. Students must submit a video that addresses several questions. Please use the link provided to find out more.  
Amount: \$25,000 – 100 Awards

### **#67 - The Jackie Robinson Foundation's Scholarship Program**

Deadline: January 10, 2024  
Criteria: The Jackie Robinson Foundation provides grants up to \$30,000 over four years to supplement the financial aid they receive from their colleges or universities. You must be a U.S. citizen in order to qualify for the Jackie Robinson Foundation Scholarship Award. In addition, you must be a graduating minority senior, demonstrate a record of academic excellence, contain leadership potential, and submit an official SAT/Act score.  
Amount: Up to \$30,000

### **#68 – J. Ollie Edmunds Distinguished Scholarship – Stetson University**

Deadline: January 15, 2024  
Criteria: Awarded to two first-year students for the Fall term 2024. This is an academic based award. Eligible students should apply for admission to Stetson University by January 15<sup>th</sup>, have a weighted GPA of at least 3.5 and be a leader in curricular activities.  
Amount: Full tuition, fees, on-campus housing, meals and books

### **#69 – American Quarter Horse Association Scholarship**

Deadline: January 15, 2024  
Criteria: To be eligible for the scholarship ideal candidates are a current AQHYA or AQHA member, and be in high school, college, or a university. Submitted applications must include a completed financial information form, three reference letters, and a high school/college transcript.  
Amount: \$35,000 – 50 Awards

**#70 – 2024 Seed Scholarship Program in Partnership with Yale Women in Economics**

Deadline: January 15, 2024  
Criteria: Accepted students will receive a \$2,000 scholarship to attend a 4 day Yale residential overnight visit and access to build college admission and college prep programs. Must be a current high school junior.  
Amount: \$2,000

**#71 - Bank of America – Charitable Foundation’s Student Leaders Program**

Deadline: January 17, 2024  
Criteria: As a Student Leader, you will participate in an eight-week paid internship at a local nonprofit organization where you will learn first-hand about the needs of your community and the critical role nonprofits play. In addition, you will learn valuable civic, social and business leadership skills. Each Student Leader will attend the Student Leaders Summit held in Washington, D.C. where you will learn how government, business and the nonprofit sector work together to address critical community needs. **#72 – Diversity Advancement Scholarship**

Deadline: January 19, 2024  
Criteria: This scholarship is awarded to help build a pipeline of architects so that the profession better reflects the diverse communities they serve. Architects Foundation is investing in the next generation of the profession by helping fund college education. Students must be enrolling into an architecture degree program.  
Amount: \$20,000 – 2 Awards

**#73 – Full Sail University - Emerging Technology Scholarship and Women in Technology Scholarship**

Deadline: January 21, 2024  
Criteria: Full Sail University is seeking accomplished students who are interested in pursuing a career in the technology industry. Our Emerging Technology Scholarship and Women in Technology Scholarship will award eligible Full Sail candidates a full-tuition scholarship toward a qualified bachelor of science degree program.

### **#74 – Points Scholarship**

Deadline: January 31, 2024

Criteria: The Points College Scholarship program was created to help students in scholarships without the hassle of filling out paper applications and writing essays. To be eligible, students must be a resident of U.S or Puerto Rico and be at least 13 years old.

Amount: \$2,500 – 12 Awards Available

### **#75 – The Michigan University - Geisinger Scholarship Program – Engineering Scholarship**

Deadline: February 4, 2024

Criteria: Scholarships will be awarded to first-year students admitted to the College of Engineering at the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor for the 2024-2025 academic year. Recipients must be enrolled full-time at the University of Michigan and pursuing an undergraduate degree program in engineering. Scholarship support is awarded for four years of undergraduate study or through graduation, whichever is less; annual renewal is contingent on satisfactory academic progress and maintaining a cumulative GPA of 3.0.

Amount: \$20,000

### **#76 – Davidson Fellows Scholarships**

Deadline: February 14, 2024

Criteria: The Davidson Fellows Scholarship awards \$50,000, \$25,000 and \$10,000 scholarships to extraordinary young people, 18 and under, who have completed a significant piece of work. Please see website for more information.

### **#77 - The Hispanic College Fund**

Deadline: February 15, 2024

Criteria: Applicants must be a U.S. citizen or a permanent resident residing in the 50 states or Puerto Rico. Students must have a minimum GPA of a 3.0 on a 4.0 scale. Students must plan to enroll as a full-time undergraduate student. Each scholarship program has its own set of criteria. Each scholarship application will state the full list of requirements for each program, please see website.

Amount: \$500-\$5,000 based on need

### **#78 - Moody's Mega Math Challenge**

Deadline: February 23, 2024

Criteria: Moody's Mega Math Challenge is an online math competition. There are no registration or participation fees, and scholarship prizes total \$100,000. Please see website for more details.

### **#79 - The Dream.US National Scholarship**

Deadline: February 29, 2024

Criteria: Applicants must have DACA; TPS; or came to the country before November 1, 2017, and otherwise meet the DACA criteria;  
Must have come to the United States before the age of 16 (if you were born in the U.S. – you are not eligible for our scholarship)  
Must have significant unmet financial need; Have graduated or will graduate from a United States high school (or have earned or will earn a high school equivalency diploma) by the end of the 2021-22 academic year; Graduated or will graduate with a GPA of 2.5 or better on a 4.0 scale  
Are eligible for in-state tuition at the Partner College you want to attend (not applicable if it is a private Partner College).

Amount: Varies

### **#80 – Columbus Citizens Foundation Scholarship Programs**

Deadline: March 1, 2024

Criteria: Eligible students must have a minimum GPA of 3.5, minimum of 25% Italian Heritage, able to provide the most recent federal tax documentation in the application, and must be an entering freshman in college or medical school.

Amount: Multiple awards up to \$6,250

### **#81 - American Legion Auxiliary – Spirit of Youth Scholarship Fund**

Deadline: March 1, 2024

Criteria: Recipients are attendees at the ALA Girls Nation Program in Washington, D.C., and the selection is made via vote by their peers. Scholarship monies are dispersed directly to the four-year accredited college or university, per the recipients' direction, and may be used for tuition, books, fees, and other appropriate expenses.

Amount: \$5,000

### **#82 - American Legion Auxiliary – Children of Warriors National Presidents' Scholarship**

Deadline: March 1, 2024

Criteria: These scholarships are for undergraduate study only at a four-year accredited college or university, and may be used for tuition, books, fees, room, and board. Candidates for this award shall be daughters, stepdaughters, sons, stepsons, grandsons, step grandsons, granddaughters, step-granddaughters, great-granddaughters, step-great granddaughters, great-grandsons, step-great-grandsons of veterans who served in the Armed Forces during eligibility dates for membership in The American Legion.

Amount: \$5,000 – 15 Awards

**#83 - American Legion Auxiliary – Non-Traditional Student Scholarships**

Deadline: March 1, 2024

Criteria: Applicant must be a member of The American Legion, Auxiliary, or Sons of the American Legion. Dues must have been paid for the two preceding years and for calendar year in which the application is made. Applicant may be pursuing training in a certified, trade, professional, or technical program, or a two-year or four-year degree program

Amount: \$2,000

Deadline: March 5, 2024

Criteria: Scholarship awards are based on the following criteria. Financial Need - Community Service - Academic Performance - School Service

**#85 - Cristin Ann Bambino Scholarship**

Deadline: March 11, 2024

Criteria: Available to a college or technical school-bound special education student with an active IEP or 504 plan from the NYSIR-member school district to reward him/her for working through special challenges to complete high school.

Amount: \$3,000 and \$5,000

**#86 – Joseph Goncalves Scholarship**

Deadline: March 11, 2024

Criteria: Available to a student who demonstrates an involvement and work for a cause or organization that promotes social justice, equal opportunity, relief of human suffering or other aspiration generally understood to be within the meaning of humanitarian activity throughout their high school career.

Amount: \$3,000 and \$5,000

Application: Available in the Guidance office

**#87 – Jensen Scholarship**

Deadline: March 11, 2024

Criteria: Available to a student who has excelled in design in his or her high school career.

Amount: \$3,000 and \$5,000

**#88 - The Horatio Alger Association Scholarship**

Deadline: March 15, 2024

Criteria: Students who have a financial need and have exhibited integrity, and perseverance in overcoming personal adversity. Students should be involved in co-curricular and community service activities.

Amount: Varies

### **#89 - PHI DELTA KAPPA - Prospective Educator Scholarship Program**

Deadline: April 3, 2024

Criteria: High school seniors who are considering a career in education. Applicants must be in good standing with Educators Rising, Educators Rising Collegiate, Lambda Theta, and PDK Association.

Amount: \$500 - \$2000
