#15 - United States Hispanic Leadership Institute (USHLI)

Deadline: November 30, 2022

Criteria: Students are required to submit a self-description and a leadership essay, submit transcripts/resume/portrait picture, two letters of recommendation

Amount: \$1,000 (4-year school) \$500 (2-year school)

#16- Long Island NAACP ACT-SO Program

Deadline: Students must attend workshops offered from November – March.

Criteria: ACT-SO is an acronym for Afro-Academic, Cultural, Technological and Scientific Olympics. The program is open to African-American high school students. Please see application for details and more information.

Amount: \$1,000-\$2,000

#17 – The NHS Scholarship

Deadline: All parts are due by November 30th, 2022

Criteria: Applicants must be High School Seniors who are National Honor Society (NHS) members in good standing of an affiliated NHS chapter.

Amount: Varies - up to \$25,000
