Dr. Farrelly thanked the community for joining. She mentioned that last week was Supervisors and Administrators recognition week. On behalf of the Board of Education, she thanked school supervisors and administrators for all the support they provide our students, staff, and faculty. She continued to discuss the Bond Referendum, scheduled voting to take place on Tuesday December 6th to address the following facilities needs:

- SHS Roof Construction, South Bay Elementary School Water Service Lines and Boiler Condensate Tank, South Bay sitework driveway, reconstruction and upgraded draining.

Dr. Farrelly explained thoroughly that it was important to note that with state building aid close to 65% for the school district and the retirement of old school district debt, it is anticipated there will be NO additional cost to the taxpayers for this project. She reiterated, the project cost would be cost neutral to the taxpayers.
